QR System Development 2014 – January 2015

In support of the development of the Hong Kong Qualifications Framework (HKQF) spearheaded by the Education Bureau (EDB), HKCAAVQ has conducted a series of system enhancements on the QR in consultation with the EDB and the Qualifications Framework Secretariat (QFS). These HKQF developments are:

- Award Titles Scheme (ATS)
- Use of QF Credit; and
- Credit Accumulation and Transfer (CAT)

QR System Enhancement E18: Implementing "Credit Accumulation and Transfer (CAT)" on the QR

Background: To put in place the QR system enhancement on CAT so as to allow the indication of CAT arrangements on an individual programme basis on the QR.

To search for CAT programmes and operators on the QR:

A new orange icon labeling "CAT" is used for programmes with CAT information (similar to other programmes with icons, e.g. LP, NLQ, and SCS) in the Search Result / Shortlisted Results pages;

➢For the search of Operators / Assessment Agencies, the orange "CAT" icon will be displayed in the operator mailing label; and

>A new data field is added in the QR Record Details page for the input of web-link leading to the CAT information on the operator's website.



QR System Enhancement E18: Implementing "Credit Accumulation and Transfer (CAT)" on the QR

1st Phase (22 July 2014)

Incorporation of new search features in the Qualifications Search page.

Users can search for learning programmes with CAT information.

2nd Phase (7 October 2014)

- Incorporation of new search features in the Operators / Assessment Agencies Search page.
- Users can search for operators with learning programmes that contain CAT information.
- > Operators with CAT information are indicated with the CAT icon.

(NB: Some of these enhancement features have been superseded by those of QR system enhancement E20 rolled out on 2 January 2015.)



QR System Enhancement E19 (Part 1): Uploading service for existing programmes with Credit Accumulation and Transfer (CAT) arrangements on the QR

Background:

- (a) To keep QR operators informed on the introduction of CAT by the EDB; and
- (b) To facilitate the timely indication of the CAT information on existing programmes registered on the QR, HKCAAVQ invited QR operators from both the self-accrediting and HKCAAVQ-accredited sectors to participate in the indication of CAT arrangements on the QR in August 2014.

Features and Timeline:

This was a special one-off bulk upload service offered by the HKCAAVQ where the CAT information of individual programmes and the corresponding CAT web-links were published collectively on the QR.

1st batch of upload (in October 2014)	44 records	2 operators
2nd batch of upload (in November 2014)	492 records	7 operators



QR System Enhancement E19 (Part 2): Implementing the new search criterion "Specification of Generic (Foundation) Competencies-based Programmes (SGC) on QR

Background:


In support of the introduction of the Specification of Generic (Foundation) Competencies (SGC) formulated by the Education Bureau (EDB) under the QF, the HKCAAVQ created this new Qualification Type to identify such programmes on the QR.

Features and Timeline:

≻Launched on the QR on 2 January 2015

Public users can search for SGC-based programmes and these programmes are indicated with the SGC icon.







QR System Enhancement E20: Introduction of the Two Types of CAT Information on QR: CAT (Institutional) and CAT (Programme)

Background: In support of the CAT initiative implemented by the EDB and alongside the readiness of some operators to indicate programme-specific CAT arrangements on the QR, such a differentiation of CAT arrangements into two types is a significant move towards the concept of implementing a dedicated repository for CAT information on the QR.

Features:

- (1) Launched on 2 January 2015.
- (2) Credit Accumulation and Transfer (Institutional) The CAT arrangements are in place at an institutional level that apply across a cognate group of learning programmes offered by the institution. An **Orange CAT** icon will be used on the QR to distinguish qualifications that are CAT (Institutional).
- (3) Credit Accumulation and Transfer (Programme) The CAT arrangements are in place at the programme level that apply to specific learning programme(s). These programme specific CAT arrangements should be underpinned by CAT arrangements at an institutional level. A Golden CAT icon will be used on the QR to distinguish qualifications that are CAT (Programme).



QR System Enhancement E21: Re-configuration of "Industry" and "Branch" search fields


Background:

- Merge the mature ITACs with similarities with an expansion of the scope of the existing Chinese Catering ITAC in light of the operational experience in developing the QF by the EDB; and
- Improve the visual presentation of the "Industry" and "Branch" data fields on the QR and facilitate the qualifications search using the two data fields by the general public.
- Use the updated "Area of Study and Industry/Branch Mapping Table" for the revised Industry / Branch codes to facilitate operators' uploading of QR records via QR Excel upload template.



Features:

- Launched on the QR on 2 January 2015
- Combined the two industries of "Beauty" and "Hairdressing" into one new industry, namely, "Beauty and Hairdressing";
- Re-titled the existing industry of "Chinese Catering" to "Catering" for the expansion of the industry scope; and
- Rearranged the naming sequence of all industry and branch titles listed in the pull-down menu of the Qualifications Search page and the Operators/ Assessment Agencies Search page by alphabetical order (A-Z).


Update on the Subsidy for QR Registration Fees (QR Subsidy)

The Education Bureau established the Qualifications Framework Fund (QF Fund) on 1 September 2014 to provide a steady source of income to support the sustainable development and implementation of QF.

Under the new subsidy for QR Registration Fees (QR Subsidy), the Government now fully bears both the registration and hosting fees.

Coverage period – Recurrent







QR Fees Refund

- Refund arrangement is to be completed in the 1st Quarter of 2015 (tentative)
- Procedures for the Refund Exercise:
 - Email notification to QR Operators for administrative arrangements of the refund
 - Confirmation by QR Operators on account payee names and contact address
 - Issuance of Cheque / Credit Notes by HKCAAVQ for delivery to QR Operators
